


Posting your sign in a frame is recommended, as it offers the most protection and will give the most longevity to the sign. However if you post your sign without a frame, we recommend using a stainless steel or nylon washer along with a panhead (roundhead) screw.

## Tools Required

- Cordless Drill with a 3/16" bit
- Screwdriver
- #8 Panhead Screws (preferably vandal resistant)
- Stainless Steel or Nylon Washers



## Installation

1. Drill 3/16" holes in your preferred location.
2. Hold sign flush against surface and align holes.
3. Fasten using screws (a cordless screwdriver may be used to get it started, but should be finished up by hand to ensure that the top laminate does not stretch.) The screw should be slightly snug against the sign face.

## Caring for Your Interpretive Signs

- Mild soap and water is best for general cleaning and regular maintenance. Rinse with clean water after washing.
- Graffiti (paint, crayon, felt tip marker, etc.) can be removed using organic solvents, such as Simple Green, Goof Off, or similar non-abrasive, citrus-based cleaners.
- Very stubborn graffiti may require stronger solvents, such as mineral spirits. Lacquer thinner can be used sparingly as a last resort by dampening a clean soft rag and moving it lightly over the surface.

InterpreTUFF signs have a 5 year limited warranty against manufacturing defects, including fading of graphics, when signs are properly installed and maintained.
